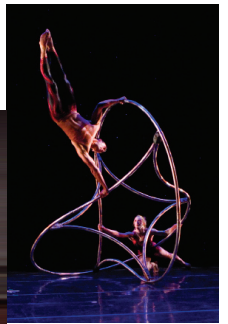
We strive to make life in the Bitterroot Valley pleasantly social, dramatically richer and more culturally stimulating.
